Technical Specifications

Jason Windows colours go through independent scratch and mar testing.

Scratch Test:

Using a 1mm tungsten carbide scratch tip, a 40mm long linear path is imparted onto the surface of the sample. The test commences using a weight of 350gms on the scratch tip shaft. This is increased in 100gm increments until 10 tests have been performed with a final weight of 1350gms. The scratches are then assessed for visibility at a standard viewing distance and angle and for 'feel' (ie: at what stage can the scratch be felt using a fingernail). The results are rated on a scale of 1 to 10 with 1 being the least resistant and 10 the most resistant.

Mar (Scuffing) Test:

Using a range of five different abrasive pads attached to a block on the abraser shaft, a cycle of 25 passes with each pad is made on the surface commencing with the least abrasive of the pads. The results are assessed visually from a standard viewing distance and angle and rated on a scale of 1 to 10.

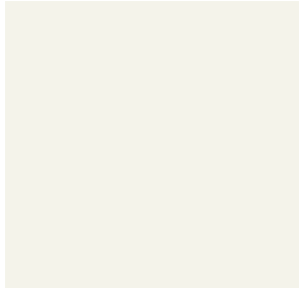

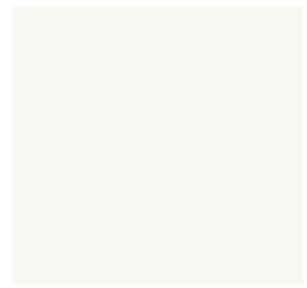
